

## Communicable Diseases

Staff shall be alert to signs of illness and communicate and refer children with symptoms to the Nurse Supervisor. Children who have a communicable disease shall follow protective measures recommended by the Nurse Supervisor.

The Nurse Supervisor will notify the Administrative Director of the County Health Department, if necessary, of all communicable disease cases in the school.

Parents/guardian will be notified.

## Communicable Diseases

When NWBOCES administration determines that a situation that is cause for special precautions, through consultation with a physician, agency, or the Nurse Supervisor the following actions will be implemented:

The administrative team and the Nurse Supervisor shall determine:

1. The seriousness of the situation.
2. Area and or person which will be restricted.
3. Any restrictions that need to be placed on staff or students.
4. Contact parents/guardian of infected students if necessary.
5. Need of physician, county or state health department or medical agency.
6. Any other procedure or restrictions that will be implemented.

In regard to employees and employment duties:

1. Shall inform the staff as to the nature of the student's disease.
2. Will utilize staff as deemed safe and appropriate by medical authorities.
3. Will require physician's statement if any staff should not be in contact with contagious area.

If the student cannot be in attendance at school, a plan will be made for care of the student at home for day students, or at the residence for residential students.

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
