

Curriculum Development

Constant adaptation and development of the curriculum is necessary if NWBOCES is to meet the needs of students at Big Horn Basin Children's Center.

Curriculum development must be carried out as a collaborative enterprise involving staff members, under the leadership of the Administrative Director and using all available resources.

The NWBOCES Board expects its faculty and administration to annually evaluate the education program and to recommend modifications of practice, changes in curriculum content, and the addition of new programs.

The Board will hear regular reports on NWBOCES programs and on-going curriculum study and revision. It will consider the recommendations of the staff for intensive curriculum study and may authorize the establishment of curriculum committees to work in particular areas. The NWBOCES Board will also be receptive to the concerns of parents/guardians and students in considering changes in the curriculum.

All teachers have professional obligations to the school program beyond regular classroom duties, and these duties shall include work on curriculum committees. It is expected that all teachers will make a contribution to this work.
