

NOTIFICATION OF PESTICIDE APPLICATION
ON OR WITHIN NWBOCES BUILDINGS

Pursuant to W.S. §35-7-375, if NWBOCES receives notice of a commercial applicator licensed under W.S. §35-7-359, or a person providing notification that such person will apply a pesticide under W.S. §35-7-374 (d) on or within any building or property used by NWBOCES primarily for the education of students, including any property used by NWBOCES for students' playground, or residences NWBOCES shall notify students, teachers, and staff of the anticipated pesticide application. The Administrative Director or his/her designee shall further distribute a copy of the notice to students, teachers, and staff under his/her supervision as soon as the time the notice is received. The Administrative Director shall ensure that the notices distributed shall be marked with a distribution date, including a distribution date when the notice is distributed to students, teachers and staff and that the notices shall include information indicating the date of application, the location of application or treatment area, the pest to be controlled, the type of pesticide to be applied, and a contact for additional information. NWBOCES shall retain the notices distributed for one year following the application of the pesticide.

NWBOCES shall, prior to application of the pesticide, coordinate with the applicator and coordinate with the applicator to ensure that signs are posted on the building or property stating the date of application, the location of the application or treatment area, the name and type of pesticide to be applied, and the contact for additional information. NWBOCES, upon request, shall provide information on how to obtain additional information on the pesticide. Not less than twelve (12) hours before application of a pesticide within school buildings, signs shall be posted at main entrances to school buildings and at entrances to the specific application area within the buildings. If pesticide application is made in any area adjacent to a school building or on property used by

for student activities or playgrounds, signs shall immediately adjacent to the treated area and at the e NWBOCES property. The signs shall remain posted for seven hours.

Anti-microbial pesticides, defined by W.S. §35-7-354(d) disinfects and sanitizers used by school employees for purposes and insect or rodent-bait stations of the type available for home use are exempted from the notification and posting requirements described above.
