

Instructional Materials

Materials for school classrooms shall be selected by the appropriate certified personnel in consultation with administration and faculty. Final decisions on purchases shall rest with the Administrative Director or his/her designee. Professional staff may purchase additional materials for their classroom at their own expense and discretion. NW BOCES administration reserves the right to determine if any purchased materials are inappropriate for the classroom setting and shall be removed. Any materials deemed to be inappropriate shall be immediately removed.

Materials will be selected with the following factors considered:

- To provide materials that will stimulate educational, academic and therapeutic growth;
- To provide materials that will enrich and support the curriculum taking into consideration the varied interests, abilities, and maturity levels of the pupils served;
- To provide a background of information which will enable students to make intelligent judgments in their daily lives.
- To provide materials that will assist students in working toward meeting state standards.

These principles shall serve as a guide in the selection of all instructional materials.
